***Grants and Building Fields:***

- ~ Adam reported that Airway Heights is in full cooperation with West Plains Little League. The City will allow us to use the lighted softball field and (2) fields at Sunset Elementary.
- ~ Adam also reported that in cooperation with Airway Heights and Spokane County we might possibly be building 4 baseball fields, 2 softball fields and 1 baseball field with 90' bases off of Craig Rd. Adam said we should have someone to look into this right away.
- ~ The Board agreed to form a committee to be Chaired by Darryl Krum with Chrystal Southwick, Ed Franklin, Mike Paulson, and Jim King to serve on this committee.

***Fields:***

- ~ Cheney: We have secured Salnave Fields 1 & 2, 6 days of the week and Moose 2 for 5 days
- ~ Medical Lake: We will have the same agreement as last year. It was reported that we will have Waterfront 1 6 days a week, but this needs to be confirmed.
- ~ Adam Smith gave a report about building fences at the Cheney fields.
- ~ We need to make sure the box is behind the bleachers. (We will do this at try-outs)

***10 Year Old Try-outs:***

There was plenty of discussion, but decided to table this matter for future consideration.

***Coaches Meeting Items:***

- ~ The city of Cheney will be giving us rules to abide by at their field and facilities.
- ~ Coaches need to pick-up litter after each game.
- ~ Coaches Meeting is scheduled for March 16, 2005 at 6:30 PM at Cheney High School

***Returning Coaches:***

Mike Paulson reported that before soliciting for coaches we need to see what our final registration numbers are going to be.

***Junior Program:***

- ~ Adam reported we are in cooperation with Spokane North and South to develop this program. ~
- ~ Adam is the contact person for West Plains.
- ~ Currently there are 11 people signed-up.
- ~ Adam discussed the drafting procedures by the other leagues. The Board did not like these procedures, and it was decided to adopt the same procedures as we did for Majors.

***Softball Update:*** We need more players to sign-up.

***Fundraising:***

- ~ Ed Franklin gave a report about raffling in the state of Washington. To do more than 1 raffle we would have to get a license from the state. This license would cost \$170. With this license we can do as many raffles as we want, and kids could legally sell tickets.
- ~ It was moved/seconded/passed for Ed to secure this license for \$170.
- ~ Adam directed Ed to get a check from Darryl Krumm to purchase the license
